You will be required to provide details of three referees, one of whom should be your current or most recent employer and one for your employer prior to that, ensuring that you account for the last two years of your employment history in your application. Referees should not be related to you and should be able to give an assessment of your professional abilities as well as your character. The secretariat reserves the right to take up all references including the current employers during the selection process.
- You would be required to produce evidence of any educational and professional qualifications to support your application, on the day of your interview.
- Salary on appointment is £250 per week gross
